TOWN OF ARLINGTON

Public Hearing at 7:00pm with Planning Commission Meeting to follow February 10, 2022

Chairman Manke opened the Public Hearing at 7:03pm, with all commission members present. Also present were Rob Roth, Ed Kallas , Jake Collins, Natia Schoepp, Tom Schoepp, and Clinton Collins.

Jake Collins & Natia Schoepp presented their request to create a two-lot Certified Survey Map for tax parcel 616 currently zoned A-1 Agriculture with a site address of County Hwy K, Arlington, WI 53911. The CSM proposes to create a new 5-acre Lot 1 to be rezoned RR-1 Rural Residence to allow for the construction of a single-family residence with Lot 2 consisting of 30 acres to remain zoned A-1 Agriculture but with an A-4 Agricultural Overlay applied to restrict any additional single family development on the 40 acres. Use existing farm driveway on Hwy K for their home driveway. There was no public input. Rob Roth did indicate a driveway permit would need to be made for a long driveway 550 ft. long, so erosion control would need to be implemented at the time of building.
