### **Sec. 1-1-1 Title/Purpose**

The Title of this Chapter is Code of Ordinances Creation. The purpose of this Chapter is to simplify, clarify and collect all Ordinances of the Town into one coherent code for ease of reference and usage.

### **Sec. 1-1-2 Authority**

This Chapter is enacted under the authority of § 66.0103, Wis. Stats.

### **Sec. 1-1-3 Code of Ordinances**

The Town Code of Ordinances is hereby adopted and enacted as the “Code of Ordinances of the Town of Arlington, Wisconsin” and shall be treated and considered as a new and original comprehensive Ordinance which shall supersede all other general and permanent ordinances of the Town passed on or before the effective date of this Code. No Resolution of the Town Board, or action taken by the Town meeting pursuant to Subchapter III of Chapter 60 of the Wisconsin Statutes, not specifically mentioned, is hereby repealed. Adoption of this Code shall not affect any action previously taken or permits granted or issued under Ordinances previously in effect.

### **Sec. 1-1-4 Clerk to Keep Copy**

A copy of the Code shall be kept on file in the office of the Town Clerk, preserved in loose-leaf form, or such other form as the Town Clerk may consider most expedient. It shall be the duty of the Town Clerk or someone authorized by the Town Clerk to insert in their designated places all amendments, Ordinances, or resolutions which indicate the intent of the Town Board to make the same a part of the Code when the same have been printed or reprinted in page form, and to extract from the Code all provisions which may be revealed from time to time by the Town Board. A copy of the Code shall be available for all persons desiring to examine it.

**Sec. 1-1-5 Severability**

If any provision of any Chapter included in this Code of Ordinances is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of any Chapter to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or application of any Chapter which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

**Sec. 1-1-6 Effective Date**

The Code of Ordinances shall become effective as provided by law.

**Sec. 1-1-7 Incorporation into Code of Ordinances**

This Ordinance shall be upon passage incorporated into the Code of Ordinances as Chapter 1 thereof.
